

Instruction for Abstract Preparation

Margins: Top - 1”
Bottom – 1”
LEFT – 1.5”
Right – 1”

Type: Use Times New Roman type with 12pt font for body of abstract

Title: The title should be in Times New Roman type with 14pt font, bolded, and centered be brief, but long enough to identify clearly the nature of the study. Capitalize the First Letter of Each Significant Word of the Title.

Authors: Times New Romans with 10 pt. Font centered
Initials should precede the last name.
Omit degrees and titles.
Bold the name of the author who will present the abstract.
Indicate the Principal Investigator (P.I.).
Indicate the name and location of the institution where the work was done.
